CHU's Green Grant Program is offering up to \$50,000 in grants to support sustainable initiatives in residential strata buildings.

CHU Residential Strata Insurance Policy holders who have held their policy consecutively for 3+ years are eligible to apply for grants of up to \$10,000 to help fund a sustainability initiative that improves your building or your strata community.

## Program Overview

## What do you get?

Our Green Grant Program is offering a grant pool of up to \$50,000 for the 2025–2026 financial year, with grants up to a maximum value of \$10,000.

Applications can only be made by the Body Corporate/Strata Committee/Owner of the residential strata building. Submissions by Strata Managers, Brokers or other intermediaries will not be accepted.

## What to include?

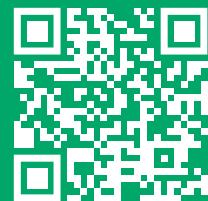
Funding is available for a broad range of initiatives that contribute to sustainability and healthier strata communities.

To be considered, your initiative must address some form of sustainability from at least one of these pillars:

- **Environmental sustainability** e.g. energy efficiency, waste reduction, water conservation
- **Social impact** e.g. community wellbeing, accessibility, safety.

Submissions must include relevant documents e.g. photos, quotes, invoices, reports.
